Christopher Wenk is the Senior Director of International Policy at the United States Chamber of Commerce, which is the world's largest business federation, representing more than three million businesses and organizations of every size, sector and region. Previously, Wenk served as the Director of International Trade Policy at the National Association of Manufacturers (NAM), which is the nation's largest industry trade association. In his capacity at the NAM, Wenk advocated on behalf of the NAM's members on international trade issues with the Administration and U.S. Congress. He also worked with NAM policy organizations to formulate positions on trade issues and managed industry group coalitions on behalf of the NAM.

Before joining the NAM, Wenk spent more than five years working on

Capitol Hill. He worked for the House Small Business Committee, Congressman Steve Chabot (R-OH) and Congressman Dave Camp (R-MI), a senior member of the House Ways and Means Committee. He also interned at the Delegation of the European Commission in Washington, D.C.

Wenk has appeared on CSPAN's Washington Journal, PBS' Nightly Business Report and CNBC's Morning Call. He was born and raised in Ann Arbor, Michigan and attended Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana graduating with a degree in Criminal Justice and Spanish. Wenk also received a Masters degree in Political Management from the George Washington University in Washington, D.C. He is married to Elizabeth Wenk, who serves as a Senior Associate for Public Policy at Burness Communications in Bethesda, Maryland. They have two daughters.
