**Former Pennsylvania Congressman Philip English to Appear Live from the G-20 Summit on The Neal Asbury Show the week of September 23rd**



**WASHINGTON, DC** – Former US Congressman Phil English, R.-Penn., will be available in Pittsburgh September 23-25 for the G-20 Summit of the world's leading financial nations.

Congressman English became a nationally-known expert in US trade policy during his 14 years in Congress. As a life long resident of western Pennsylvania, Congressman English knows the economy of Pittsburgh first hand and the importance of holding an international trade summit in the Midwest.

"I have watched the economy of Western Pennsylvania lose to interna-

tional competition, and I am watching its rebirth because of international cooperation" said Mr. English. "Setting a G-20 Summit in Pittsburgh is more than symbolic; it's an actual example of what sensible trade policy can create."

Congressman English served seven terms in the United States House of Representatives, representing Western Pennsylvania's 3rd District from 1995 to 2009.

While serving on the Ways & Means Trade Subcommittee, Mr. English was a Co-Chair of the Congressional Service Industries Caucus and a member of the President's Export Council. He also served on the Joint Economic Committee, was Chairman of the Steel Caucus, and was a Congressional Representative on the official US Delegation to the controversial WTO Ministerials in Seattle and Cancun.

Congressman English will bring a Pennsylvanian, federal, and international perspective on events inside the Convention Center and on the streets of Pittsburgh where anti-globalization protestors will try to dominate the coverage. "I've seen these protests firsthand in Seattle and think they are less than what they appear to be." said Mr. English.

Congressman English is an advocate of public diplomacy and America's role in world affairs. He served as Co-Chair of the House European Union Caucus, the House Brazil Caucus, the House Morocco Caucus, the House Swiss Caucus, and the House World Bank Caucus. He is a long time advocate of American manufacturing and global rules-based trade. He was the author of the Trade Rights Enforcement Act, as well as Co-chair of the World Bank Caucus, Co-chair of the EU Caucus, and a member of the Transatlantic Policy Network.

Mr. English is currently a member of the US Advisory Commission on UNESCO and a Senior Government Relations Advisor to one of the leading international trade law firms, Arent Fox in Washington, DC.

"This conference is also a great opportunity for the Greater Pittsburgh community to showcase its vitality as the home of world class institutions and community leaders," said Mr. English.
